

# Behaviours we reject –25

Grace, thankfulness, trust, justice, aspiration and celebration are at the heart of The King's values. We reject, in the strongest terms, those behaviours that do not enable you to become good and honest citizens in today's world. Such behaviours should play no part in your development and they are ones which we sanction because they have no place in our school and wider community.

## Poor Punctuality

- Arriving late for school
- Arriving late to lesson
- Arriving late to assemblies
- Arriving late to Chapter time
- Truanting from school or lessons

## Poor Language

- Using the Lords' name in vain
- Not speaking in full sentences
- Swearing – both verbal and gestured
- Comments design to induce fear or to intimidate
- Comments that incite others to act negatively towards another

## Poor Organisation

- Having no school bag
- Having no equipment
- Failing to display a Standards card (Y7, 8 & 9)
- Failing to submit homework on time
- Leaving exercise books at home
- Exercise books not following the school presentation policy

## Disrupting Learning

- Talking over the teacher
- Shouting out in lessons and not putting a hand up
- Moving around a class without permission
- Actively distracting other students
- Refusing to follow instructions from staff
- Throwing objects
- Asking distracting/ irrelevant questions
- Mobile phone turned on – lesson or corridor

## Disrespect

- Not showing respect to adults in school e.g. rudeness and not following instructions
- Challenging an adult's authority
- Not valuing or affirming peers (verbally or physically – including via social media)
- Littering the school building and grounds
- Intentionally damaging school or another students property
- Damaging the school's reputation in the wider community

## Intolerance

- Making comments, actions or gestures of a racist, sexual, homophobic or discriminative nature
- Making comments and actions design to denigrate a person's religious beliefs
- Not showing compassion when others are facing difficult times
- Not being prepared to listen to and understand another's point of view
- Display a lack of patience

## Poor Uniform

- Wearing trainers
- Missing or wearing incorrect items
- Wearing fake items- hair, nails and eyelashes
- Wearing jewellery other than a watch and/or a single pair of stud earrings
- Wearing excessive make up and fake tan
- Not wearing the correct PE kit

## Poor Engagement

- Not completing homework
- Showing a defeatist attitude
- Refusing to take on a challenge
- Refusing to take part in discussions
- Taking no pride in the presentation of work
- Failing to learn lessons from previous errors of judgement
- Refusing to act on verbal or written feedback

## Lack of Self-Control

- Abuse towards others – verbal or physical
- Using aggressive language and/ or actions towards another individual
- Having uncontrolled, violent outbursts
- Needing to have the last word
- Repeating the same errors of judgement
- Bringing banned items onto the school site
