Info-graphics	<div>Reduce a large body of text in to a visual, bitesize infographic</div> <div></div> <div><p><b>Tip</b> Follow the 3S framework</p><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ 1. Select the most important information</li><li>➤ 2. Split up the information into logical parts</li><li>➤ Sequence the parts to tell a compelling story</li></ul></div>	<div></div>
Dual coding	<div>Transforming the written word into pictures using visual cues</div> <div><div></div><div></div></div> <div><p><b>Tip</b> Use a range of artistic clues. Keep pictures simple - avoid sentences or paragraphs and instead use:</p><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Letters – to signify characters/ people/ places</li><li>➤ Colour – to signify meaning</li><li>➤ Words – kept to an absolute minimum</li><li>➤ Symbols – used in place of words</li></ul></div>	<div></div>

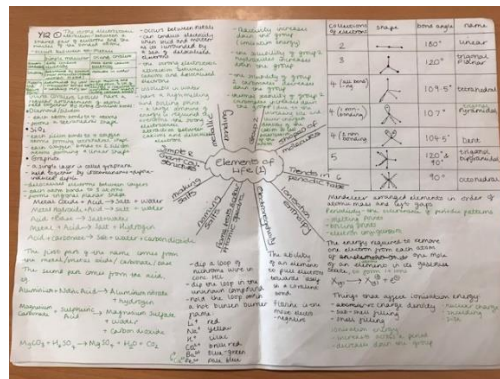

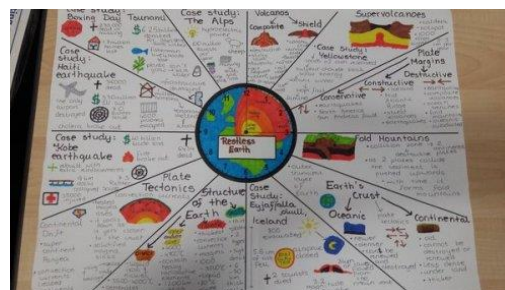
