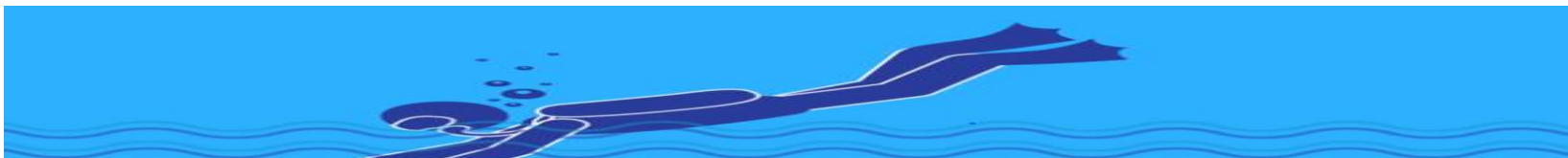
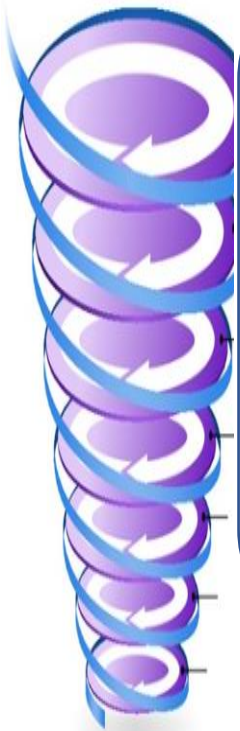




INTENT:
