There are some option subjects that may not be suited to a particular student's skill set, in these circumstances, the final decision as to whether a student will be successful on a course will be made by the school. Some subjects require a substantial amount of coursework so priority will be given to those students who consistently achieve a grade 1 or 2 for 'commitment to homework'.

Please note if not enough students select a given course, then it is not viable to run.
